

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION & DISPLAY OF POSTERS

Each poster will put up on **day 1 (29 April 2016 at 8.00 am)** and be displayed for **all 2 days** (29& 30 April 2016) (Registration will start at 7.30 am). The Poster session is a graphic presentation of your work. Poster presentations are increasingly being considered the most effective way of communicating with fellow researchers, as it provides a platform for one to one interaction. Therefore, in this conference most of the free papers will be in the form of posters. The evaluation will be done by the experts. **At least one author should be available at site for interaction.** Poster Evaluation will start at 8.00 am from day 1.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER DISPLAY

1. Poster sessions consist of rows of posters on similar topics. The poster boards will be numbered (session numbers will be indicated at the end of each row of boards). You will be provided with the number of your poster board. There may be multiple poster sessions scheduled concurrently, so be sure to identify the correct row of boards for your session as well as the appropriate board number as provided to you by the Poster Help Desk and indicated in the program, before arranging your poster.
2. The Organisers will provide poster boards.
3. The board area for sticking your poster measures approximately **length 120 cm X breadth 80 cm (Orientation is portrait)**. Pins for mounting the poster will be available at the site. **Do not exceed these size limits.**
4. Bring about 10-20 numbers of handouts (A4 or legal size paper printout of poster) to distribute to viewers. Highlight the authors names and contacts in case the viewer is interested in contacting them for more information. No audiovisual equipment is permitted for poster presentations.
5. The conference will NOT offer presenters any additional media for the poster sessions (videos, audios, Internet/computer connection).
